## Notes from the Board Meeting held January 23

Proposal for a new member was received, Dale Twomley who has been a Rotarian since 1984 in Ohio, and unanimously approved by the Board. He is Principal at the Shenandoah Valley Academy.

The GSE 7 person team from Brazil will be visiting Area 2 and every club in the area has been asked to look after them for a day. As Woodstock and New Market meet on the same day, April 2, New Market has agreed to collect 3 of them from the Timberville Community Center and take them to the America on Parade Museum first, then bring them to lunch at our meeting where they will make a presentation. Afterwards they will be taken to the New Market Battlefield and given a tour. Finally they will have dinner with some of our members and Nanda at a home before returning them to the Community Center to be picked up by their host families in Broadway.

It was agreed by the Board to present a donation of \$300 to the Stonewall Jackson High School for the After Prom Party. Also a check for \$2500 will be issued to the Shenandoah County Soccer Complex to purchase a set of goals and nets which will

be permanently marked as being donated by the New Market Rotary Club.

Checks for \$500 each will be presented to the New Market Fire Department and the Rescue Squad when it can be arranged for them to give a short report. (Possibly April 23 or 30)

2 Items worth \$25 each for the District Governors Conference door prizes and 1 gift worth \$100 for the silent auction will be purchased.

Proposal from Larry Strawderman for a social outing on June 15 to go to the presentation of "Singing in the Rain", was discussed and agreed that if members were interested after hearing a presentation by Larry at the January 30<sup>th</sup> meeting, we would go ahead and book the bus with a \$200 deposit.

Bev Holsinger reported on the Cash Party for March 29 and she will be getting her sub committee together to make the final arrangements. It was agreed to have a Overseas trip as the first prize, as last year, but offer the amount that it would cost the club as a cash prize if preferred by the winner.

Discussion was held on a further fund raiser to be held before the end of the 2007/2008 year so that funds will be available to support the 2008/2009 year.
