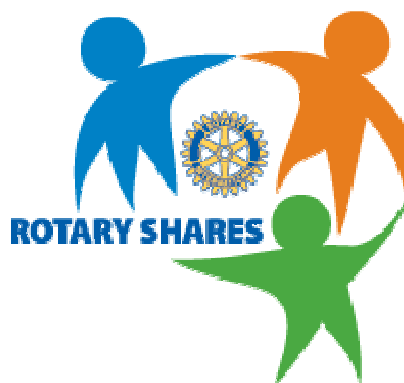

District Conference, March 14/16

Adults attending the Conference for the
whole weekend are charged \$120 each
(\$140 after Feb 7) registration fee and
this year the weekend tickets include
both the Foundation Lunch on Saturday
and the Evening Banquet.

The Homestead room rate for double
occupancy is \$282 per night which
includes dinner at the restaurant of your
choice on Friday night, breakfast (huge)
on Saturday and Sunday mornings. 15%
resort service and 7% state tax is added.

In our budget for this year we included a
\$250 contribution towards these costs
per couple for up to 5 couples. If you wish
to attend, please let Philip Crown know as
soon as possible - first come first served!
Hotel bookings get taken early so it is
important to get your reservation in.
It is a great experience for anyone who
really wants to find out what Rotary is all
about - both Internationally and in our
District - just ask any of our members
who have been to one or more of the
Conferences.
